A. The _____ of Persia (11:1-2)

Daniel 11:2 “And now I will tell you the truth; Behold, three more kings will arise in Persia, and the fourth shall be far richer than them all; by his strength, through his riches, he shall stir up all against the realm of Greece.”

B. The _____ of Alexander (11:3-4)

Daniel 11:3 “Then a mighty king shall arise, who shall rule with great dominion, and do according to his will. **4** And when he has arisen, his kingdom shall be broken up and divided toward the four winds of heaven, but not among his posterity nor according to his dominion with which he ruled; for his kingdom shall be uprooted, even for others besides these.”

Daniel 11:5 “Also the king of the South shall become strong, as well as one of his princes; and he shall gain power over him and have dominion. His dominion shall be a great dominion.

Daniel 11:6 And at the end of some years they shall join forces, for the daughter of the king of the South shall go to the king of the North to make an agreement; but she shall not retain the power of her authority, and neither he nor his authority shall stand; but she shall be given up, with those who brought her, and with him who strengthened her in those times.”

Daniel 11:23a “And after the league is made with him he shall act deceitfully...”

Daniel 11:24 “...he shall do what his fathers have not done, nor his forefathers: he shall disperse

among them the plunder, spoil, and riches...”

Daniel 11:24b “...he shall devise his plans against the strongholds, but only for a time.”

Daniel 11:31 “And forces shall be mustered by him and they shall defile the sanctuary fortress then they shall take away the daily sacrifices, and place there the abomination of desolation.”

Daniel 11:32b “but the people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits.”
