Selected Scriptures (NKJV)

**Matthew 26:21** "Assuredly, I say to you, one of you will betray Me."

**25** Then Judas, who was betraying Him, answered and said, "Rabbi, is it I?" He said to him, "You have said it."

**John 13:30** Having received the piece of bread, he then went out immediately. And it was night.

**Matthew 26:26** And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, blessed (gave thanks for) and broke it, and gave it to the disciples...

**Matthew 26:26** "Take eat; this is My body."

**Luke 22:19** "This is My body which is given for you."

**John 6:35** "I am the bread of life, He who comes to Me shall never hunger."

**Luke 22:19** "Do this in remembrance of Me."

## 3. The \_\_\_\_\_ at the Lord's table

**Matthew 26:27** Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. **28** For this is My blood."

**1 Corinthians 10:16** The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ?

**Leviticus 17:11** For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.

**Genesis 3:21** Also for Adam and his wife the Lord God made tunics of skin, and clothed them.

## 4. The \_\_\_\_\_ at the Lord's table

**Luke 22:20** "This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you."

**Ezekiel 36:27** “I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.”

**Jeremiah 31:31** “Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah.”
